



KINGSTON WOMEN'S ART FESTIVAL

Festival Guidelines

APPLYING

The Kingston Women's Art Festival is now a juried show. Artists must apply for this festival. The deadline for artist entries is Friday, April 10th. Artists participate at their own risk. The Festival is not liable for damage, loss, or theft of artwork or personal belongings. The Kingston Women's Art Festival goes on, rain or shine!

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO EXHIBIT IN THE WOMEN'S ART FESTIVAL?

The Festival is open to women artists who design and create original artwork. The total body of work must be handmade by the woman artist who applies. Each artist must apply separately and the non-refundable \$75 fee (Regular booth location) or \$90 fee (Premium booth location) applies to each space. If sharing a booth with another artist, you must each register separately and each pay a \$37.50 fee (Regular) or \$45 fee (Premium). We encourage and appreciate the support of male partners and friends. However, we request that in keeping with the spirit of the festival, women artists must be present to interpret their work and manage their displays even when displaying with others.

IS THERE ANYTHING AN ARTIST MAY NOT SELL?

Artists may not sell food products (without proper licensing and permits from the city), plants, kit/production lines, direct sales, imported goods or other artists' work. Artists who attempt to sell these items will be asked to remove them from their display. Please go to the about section for more information about this festival and its mandate.

FESTIVAL INFORMATION BOOTH

The Women's Art Festival Information booth is located near the City Park building (where the washrooms are situated). Please check in with the information booth upon your arrival at the Festival. We will confirm your booth location within the park and provide you with your Participant Registration Card which must be visible on your display.

DISPLAY CONSIDERATIONS

Displays should be simple and well-anchored. Participants are responsible for all chairs, tables and weather protection. We are too large for a rain location, so we ask that you use your own judgment should the weather



turn unpleasant.

DISPLAY AREAS

Booth spaces are marked with paint lines. Please take only the space allotted to you. Please ask Festival staff if you are unsure of where to set up. Booths are marked off at roughly 12'x12' and booths can be no larger than 10'x10'. Adjust accordingly if you've booked a double booth.

UNLOADING, SET UP AND PARKING

******NEW THIS YEAR - ABSOLUTELY NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED IN CITY PARK - THIS INCLUDES DURING SET UP AND TAKE DOWN****** You must park outside the park and walk your items in. Pull carts are permitted. There is free parking available in the streets surrounding the park, just be sure to pay attention to the signs as not all areas provide free parking on Sundays.

EARLY SETUP

Again this year artists will have the option by special request to set up Saturday, between 5:00 and 7:00 p.m. Overnight security has been arranged. If you wish to set up Saturday, please make sure you indicate this on your registration form. **Do not leave valuables in the park overnight.** All items are left at your own risk. *****You must leave the park by 7pm. Anyone in the park after 7pm will be considered trespassing and be asked to leave by security. Failure to do so may result in removal from the event.*****

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Food and beverages will be available for purchase from local vendors. Accessible washroom facilities are available on-site.

ACCESSIBILITY

City Park is an accessible venue, all display areas are on paved pathways.

FESTIVAL DAY INFORMATION FOR REGISTERED ARTISTS

Please note the following festival day protocols:

1. Please come to the info tent between 8:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. on Sunday to register, pick up your Participant Registration Card and set up your display. Late registration at the info tent may mean your booth has been re-assigned.
2. Please see our Festival Directions document for directions to the festival site in the City of Kingston. No set-up is allowed before 8 a.m. If this happens, you risk not being admitted to the park as well as losing your registration fee.
3. Set-up must be completed by 10am.
4. Please **do not** take apart your display prior to 5pm. You must remain set up for the full duration of the festival. **Those who tear down prior to 5pm will not be permitted to participate in future events.**
